| 23        | <b>Black Ridge California Cabernet 2012.</b> A bouquet of ripe blackcurrants and blackberries. It's fruity with a smooth finish. A great wine for its bargain price.   | \$10         |
| 14        | <b>McManis Family Vineyards California Cabernet 2012.</b> Dark garnet in color with a bouquet of dark berry fruits, this wine delivers an abundance of fruit flavors with a long pleasant finish.  | \$14         |
| 11        | <b>Ramsey Cabernet Sauvignon 2012.</b> Great all around cab  | \$14         |
| 24        | <b>Rutherford Ranch Napa Valley Cabernet 2012.</b> This wine contains some Merlot and Zinfandel, making it dry in style and smooth on the palate. The blackberry and black currant flavors are delicious, accented with a savory note of black pepper.   | \$24         |
| 20        | <b>Reynolds Family Cabernet Sauvignon 2011.</b> This is a fully mature, medium-bodied, richly fruity, well-made tasty Cab with soft tannins.   | \$55         |
| 29        | <b>Montes Alpha Cabernet Sauvignon 2009.</b> This Nicely aged Cab is a glass-coating opaque purple color with aromas of wood smoke, pencil lead, scorched earth, violets, blackcurrent, and blackberry. Structured on the palate, but slightly clipped in the finish. Drink now. Rated 90 by Robert Parker   | \$33         |
| 21        | <b>Jax Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2009.</b> Tight, sleek, and focused with an elegant blend of currant, black cherry, earth and nutmeg. Great depth and finish.  | \$47         |
| 4         | <b>Frank Family Vineyards Napa Valley Cabernet 2011.</b> This Cab has dark garnet hues and rich scents of black fruit and cedar. It's well balanced with a long finish containing hints of dark chocolate.   | \$53         |
| 6         | <b>Reynolds Family Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2010.</b> A lovely core of creme de cassis, black currants and blueberries dominate this purely made, fantastic drinking Cab. Rated 90 by Wine Spectator.   | \$32         |
| 2         | <b>Rubissow Cabernet Sauvignon 2010.</b> Surprising smooth, it shows ripe fruit bursting with silky, plum, cherry and blackcurrant flavors. Nose has lovely notes of bay laurel, brown sugar, gingerbread and spices. Some compare it to 2007 Silver Oak. Rated 91 by Cellar Tracker.  | \$63         |
| 22        | <b>Red Cap Vinyards California Cabernet 2009.</b> Dark fruit and blackberry aromas fill the glass. Mixed berries, kirsch and mocha flavors anchor the palate. Finish is clean and full with lingering of juicy currant, cedar, spice and black cherry notes.   | \$63         |
| 12        | <b>Frank Family Rutherford Reserve Cabernet 2011.</b> This Cab shows beautiful purple and magenta hues with a dark opaque core. The bouquet is bright and concentrated with notes of wild berries, plums and forest herbs. As the wine opens, it reveals notes of sage, black pepper and hints of graphite. The palate is full and velvety with a fine finish. Rated 89 by Wine Spectator. | \$88         |
| 3         | <b>Rubissow Reserve Mt Veeder Cabernet Sauvignon 2007.</b> This is a big Cabernet with layers of ripe blueberry, blackberry and plum, and a backdrop of roasted coffee and buttery brioche. Only 163 cases made. Rated 90 by Wine Enthusiast.  | \$130        |

| 17 | <b>R8 2011 California Cabernet.</b> This blend of 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Syrah, and 6% Mourvedre yields ripe flavors uncommon in wines at this price. Drink now.  | \$14  |
| 27 | <b>Chateau Bel Air Haut Medoc 2010.</b> Another excellent Bordeaux from the Despagne family. It is spicy, pure, easygoing, and medium-bodied with a long anise-framed finish. Rated 90 by Wine Spectator.  | \$16  |
| 19 | <b>Kenzo Estate Rindo 2009.</b> Kenzo's flagship wine, an alluring blend of Bordeaux varietals from many parts of the estate. The components are fermented separately in small tanks and then held for 20 months in French oak barrels, yielding an elegant and balanced wine. Rated 93.9 by Cellar Tracker.   | \$130 |
| 8  | <b>Frank Family Winston Hill Proprietary Red 2010.</b> This red blend (87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Cabernet Franc, 5% Merlot and 1% Petit Verdot) from the Winston Hill AVA is the top wine of the family's vineyards. The aromatics include scents of charcoal, graphite, creme de cassis and background oak. Stunningly rich and full-bodied, this fantastic wine is long, rich and elegant. Rated 94 by Robert Parker. | \$150 |
| 13 | <b>Norton Mendoza Reserve Malbec 2013.</b> This plush red offers velvety blackberry, fig paste and currant confiture notes backed by mouthwatering ganache and espresso. A big wine! Rated 90 by Wine Spectator.   | \$14  |
| 9  | <b>Trentadue La Storia Alexander Valley Merlot 2012.</b> This Merlot has concentrated aromas and flavors of blackberry, cassis, plums, and chocolate. Rich feel with lingering ripe fruit flavors.   | \$23  |
| 25 | <b>Rutherford Ranch Napa Merlot 2012.</b> This wine offers up luscious flavors of Bing cherry, blueberry, and creamy vanilla. It's nice on the palate with a long, rich finish.  | \$24  |
| 30 | <b>Montes Alpha Merlot 2009.</b> A nicely aged, delicious Chilean Merlot blended with 15% Carmenere. Rated 90 by Robert Parker.  | \$29  |

| 1  | <b>Auteur Manchester Ridge Vineyard Pinot Noir 2012.</b> Deep colored with black fruits and spice box characteristics. Rated 90 by Robert Parker.  | \$58  |
| 16 | <b>Clos Pepe Estate Santa Rita Hills Pinot Noir 2011.</b> Offering up vivid cherry and raspberry fruit, the wine finishes with firm tannins and a pleasant spicy aftertaste. Rated 88 by Wine Spectator.   | \$68  |
| 28 | <b>Heartland South Australia Shiraz 2009.</b> Vibrant, with juicy acidity accenting generous, focused flavors of blackberry, cherry and sweet spice, lingering with intensity on the polished finish. Drink now through 2017. Rated 90 by Wine Spectator and Robert Parker.  | \$23  |
| 7  | <b>McManis California Zinfandel 2012.</b> A soft and straight forward Zinfandel with notes of cherry and herb. Drink now.  | \$14  |
| 5  | <b>Frank Family Zinfandel 2011.</b> Appealing raspberry and cinnamon aromas lead to crisp black cherry, dried sage and herb flavors. Rated 87 by Robert Parker.  | \$30  |

| 80 | <b>Rutherford Ranch Chardonnay 2012.</b> A terrific floral and tropical fruit-scented and flavored white, this wine offers notes of orange marmalade and caramelized citrus. Pure, rich and fruity, it was aged in stainless steel and oak barrels. Rated 88 by Robert Parker. | \$26 |
| 81 | <b>Jax Y3 Chardonnay 2012.</b> The wine begins with tropical finesse, fresh white fruit aromas and lingering notes of honeysuckle and sliced pear. The palate is clean with bright citrus and a nice finish. Rated 88 by Cellar Tracker.                                       | \$30 |
| 82 | <b>Black Ridge Vineyards Pinot Grigio 2012.</b> This Pinot Grigio is light bodied and crisp, with delicate fruit flavors of white peaches and orange blossoms.   | \$9  |
| 83 | <b>Rutherford Ranch Sauvignon Blanc 2013.</b> Juicy, with a tropical edge of mango flavors to the lemony citrus, melon and lime skin notes. Vibrant and intense, especially on the finish.   | \$15 |
| 84 | <b>Pheasant Ridge Chenin Blanc.</b> This crisp Texas white offers up honey with a little wet wood and honeysuckle on the nose with well-balanced green apple and melon on the palate.  | \$25 |
